

## Group Study Tours (8 days - 6 weeks)

Fee guide for agents for an 8 day (7 night) programme includes:

- 25 hours of tuition and activities per week comprising of English, sample A Level lessons, Sport, Drama, Art, Music and Orienteering according to your group's needs.
- 1 full day trip to London, Oxford or Salisbury and Stonehenge and a half day trip to Portsmouth, or Winchester or Bournemouth. Tour guide included.
- Accommodation half-board during the week and full-board at the weekend in a friendly, police-checked, family close to the college with full-support from our Welfare Officer. Lunch provided by Homestay Hosts at weekends may be a packed lunch when students are on trips.
- Lunch in the college canteen during students' time in the college.
- Airport pickup and drop off to Heathrow or Gatwick.
- 1 group leader free of charge for every 14 students (accommodation and transport only).

Please note that the fee does not include:

- Flights
- Medical or travel insurance
- Entrance fees for attractions
- Entertainment
- Agents' commission

Additional group leaders are welcome for a contribution of £140 per week. Please note we can only welcome a maximum of two group leaders for groups of 14.
